### WHAT'S HAPPENING IN YOUR AREA?

PC Tom Gibbs has been working with local communities and landowners to address associated issues such as parking obstructions along the coast. Roads Policing have been really supportive with this and have joined Tom in issuing fines where required. The main hotspots have been Sea Palling and the coast to Horsey as widely reported in the media.

Due to the ongoing telephone fraud concerns and in line with the recent SNAP priorities, PC Gibbs has been visiting post offices across his beat and getting them to hand out the new 'Norfolk Against Scams Partnership' leaflet to any customers they feel may be vulnerable or may benefit from the information, including basic advice and relevant points of contact.

PC Gibbs is also a fully trained Marine officer and is a reserve Broads Beat team member, he has been out with Broadsbeat twice now on the local rivers dealing with Covid matters and issuing warnings or guidance where appropriate, they have also patrolled our local boatyards to deter marine crime. Tom also has a number of vulnerable live-a-board residents on my beat and he has been supporting them by putting them in touch with support including the very helpful foodbank at Stalham Methodist Church.

In company with the Operational Partnership Team (OPT), PC Gibbs has been interacting with a range of vulnerable members of our community. These visits have included support and guidance for those with mental ill health, drug and alcohol addiction and those who have recently been targeted by fraudsters to ensure that they feel safe and know where to turn should they need support or advice.

### CRIME UPDATES (1st to 28th February)

Offence	Numbers	What could this entail
Arson	0	Damage caused as a result of fire.
Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)	0	Harassment, alarm or distress is caused in a non-crime incident.
Burglary business and community	0	A person commits theft in a building or structure that is not lived in.
Burglary residential	1	Entry and theft in a building or a structure that is lived in.
Criminal Damage	2	A person destroys or damages property belonging to someone else.
Domestic	2	Domestic incidents where a crime has not occurred. Parties are aged 16 or over and have been intimate partners or family members regardless of sexuality.
Hate Incident	0	Any incident where a crime has not occurred which the victim, or anyone else, thinks is based on someone's prejudice towards them because of their race, religion, sexual orientation, disability or because they are transgender.
Race or Religious aggravated public fear	0	Any crime determined to have a hate element as per above.
Possession of controlled substance	1	Unlawful possession of a drug classified in class A, B or C.
Possession of weapons	0	Unlawful possession of an article used as a weapon.
Public fear, alarm or distress	2	Public order offences e.g. from a verbal altercation to offences just short of violence.
Robbery	0	Includes a range of offences where force is used, threatened or the victim is put in fear.
Theft from a motor vehicle	0	Any item stolen that was in, on or attached to a motor vehicle.
Theft or unauthorised taking of a motor vehicle	0	Any motor vehicle including those abandoned.
Theft of pedal cycle	1	From a public place, if stolen from a shed or garage this would be a BOTD.
Theft from a person	0	Purse being taken from a handbag, or a mobile phone from a shopping basket.
